In The Nutcracker & The Battle for the Key, Clara Stahlbaum bids an emotional farewell to her twin brother Alexander as he departs for war, leaving her a precious music box as a symbol of their bond. When the war ends, Alexander returns during a festive family celebration. However, before he can give Clara the music box key, a mischievous rat steals it, leading Clara on a magical adventure orchestrated by Uncle Drosselmeyer.

In Act 1, Clara finds herself amid a battle between toy soldiers and rats. The key shatters into four pieces during the chaos, and Clara defeats the Rat Queen with the Nutcracker's help. The Snow Queen appears in a swirling snowstorm and gifts Clara the first piece of the broken key.

Act 2 takes Clara to the Land of Sweets and Flowers, where she encounters whimsical characters, vibrant dances, and the regal but scheming Sugar Plum Fairy, who secretly covets the key. Alongside the Nutcracker, Clara collects the remaining pieces of the key while facing challenges and uncovering betrayals.

In the finale, Clara bravely reclaims the last piece of the key in a climactic battle with the Sugar Plum Fairy. She returns to the party, where time has stood still, and shares her triumph with Alexander. Together, they open the music box and dance to its melody, celebrating love, family, and Clara's courage as the curtain falls.

Our Artists

Artistic Director - Serena Scheffer-Arango

Choreographer - Therese Young

Therese is a CWU Emeritus Professor of Dance who ran the CWU Dance Program and directed the performance company 'Orchesis' for 20+years. She choreographed the adult dances in the Party Scene & Finale, the twinkle party girls, and the waltzes with Alexander/Nutcracker & Clara.

Choreographer - Anna Rose

Anna has been dancing since she was four years old -- mostly ballet and contemporary, but with a little jazz in there, too! She coached Port Townsend Ballet's competition team for three seasons and directed/choreographed PTB productions Peter Pan, Alice in Wonderland, and The Nutcracker. When she's not dancing, you'll probably see her around town a lot with a camera (she's a reporter for the Daily Record) and she teaches at The Studio by EDE. Anna choreographed parts of the Battle, Prologue to Act 2, Spicy Hot Chocolate, Candy Canes, & parts of the Pas de Deux.

Choreographer - Emma Tolmich

Emma is in her fourth year at Central Washington University. She is studying Theater Production Design and Dance. Some of her favorite roles have been the lion in the Wizard of Oz and one of the 3 fairies in Sleeping Beauty. Emma has been dancing since she was 3 and loves to share her passion with others and teaches at The Studio by EDE. Emma choreographed the Ballerina Doll, The Forest of Snow, Coffee, Sweet Tea, Cotton Candy, Land of Flowers, & parts of the Pas de Deux.

Fight Choreographer - David Connolly

David is a MFA graduate in Classical Acting from George Washington University, is a skilled fight choreographer and stunt performer known for his stylized sword and knife choreography. David choreographed the fight between the Rat Queen & The Nutcracker to ensure our dancers would be safe with real swords!

Conductor: Allion Salvador

Mr. Salvador is the 1st prize winner of the 2021 Music International Grand Prix, coconcertmaster of Missoula-based String Orchestra of the Rockies, concertmaster of Seattle Metropolitan Chamber Orchestra, associate concertmaster of Yakima Symphony, quest concertmaster at Seattle's Paramount Theater, and a member of the Spokane Symphony. He is a regular guest artist with the Yakima-based Sempre Chamber Music series and SMCO Secret Chamber Music, collaborating with artists including Nathan Chan, Maria Larionoff, Joria Fleezanis, and Denise Dillenbeck. As a conductor, he is the music director of the Federal Way Youth Orchestra, associate conductor of Wenatchee Valley Symphony, visiting artist at Yakima Music en Acción, and founding music director of the Seattle Philharmonic Strings, a chamber orchestra bringing rarely played string repertoire to new communities. Mr. Salvador graduated with degrees in Violin Performance and Neurobiology from the University of Washington, and completed graduate work in violin at the University of Oregon and Manhattan School of Music. He is currently a conducting student of Nikolas Caoile at Central Washington University. His teachers include Lisa Kim and Ronald Patterson in violin, and Michael Jinbo, Kenneth Kiesler, and Ludovic Morlot in conducting. Festival appearances include the Aspen Music Festival, Round Top Music Festival, and the Pierre Monteux School.
